General Information:

Tournament date is January 19, 2022 beginning at 1:00 PM at Sparta Lanes.

Snow Date is January 20, 2022, same time.

A team trophy will be awarded to the tournament team champion. Medals will be awarded to individuals on the first and second place teams. Also, a Most Outstanding Bowler trophy will be awarded. A boys and girls Medalist Tournament will be held concurrently with the Boys Team Championship. Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers. **Schools without teams may enter either Medalist Tournament. All competitors must meet the same NJSIAA and BOE requirements for academic and medical eligibility as team members. Schools with Girls Teams would enter just in the girls tournament with a limit of 5 per school. Coed teams that are not bowling females in the boys team event, may enter their females in the individual medalist girls tournament.**

Girls can not double as members of the boys and girls teams. Meaning girls bowling for boys team can not join to make up a girls team, however, they can medal in the girls tourney.

If you have a BOE-approved girls team, you can not enter as a coed team.

Tournament Rules

- Teams must arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the tournament
- There will be a 10-20 minute practice session prior to the beginning of the H/W/S Tournament.
- Lane assignments will be determined in advance by the Tournament Director.
- Bowlers not present for any scheduled practice forfeit their time. Substitutes will receive no additional practice throws before entering competition. Violators will be disqualified from tournament play.
- To maintain the pace of bowling it is proper etiquette in this event to observe one-lane courtesy and deliver the bowling ball within a reasonable amount of time. Additional courtesy or delivery time is inappropriate, delays the pace and hinders completion of competition on time. The alternates will be assigned a lane to maintain the pace of bowling.
- During the matches substitutions may occur at any time during the match. Any bowler replaced in the middle of a match may not reenter the match until the game in which they were removed has concluded.
- Coaches are responsible for verification of their team's score. Any scoring corrections must be made prior to signing recap forms
- In the event of a tie at the completion of regulation the individual highest game from each team will break the tie to the highest team score. In the event of a high game tie, high individual 3 game series will break the tie.
